The Southern New Jersey Section of the American Society of Highway Engineers has established the William Reeves Memorial Scholarship. Following is pertinent information and guidelines for eligibility.

1. The amount and number of scholarships will be party based on the number of qualified applicants. The scholarship amount is \$2500.00.
2. The Scholarship Committee will make this award by May 2010.
3. Eligible applicants must be Civil Engineering students successfully into their sophomore, junior or senior year of study (for the 2009-2010 school year).

The student must be a US citizen and reside in one of the following counties in New Jersey:

Camden	Cape May	Gloucester
Mercer	Ocean	Salem

4. Eligible students must be maintaining at least a 2.0 grade point average.
5. No scholarship will be awarded to any student who is presently receiving 70% or more tuition help from scholarships or financial aid.
6. Need, as well as scholastics, will be considered for this award.
7. The scholarship will only be awarded to an individual one time; however students who are not awarded the scholarship may re-apply each year they are eligible.
