WILLIAM REEVES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

The Southern New Jersey Section has established a Scholarship Fund to assist student(s) in their education. This scholarship fund is directed to those students pursuing a Bachelors Degree in Civil Engineering with a stated interest in a field of engineering related to the transportation industry.

The following information and guidelines for eligibility apply to the current academic year:

1. This application is for the _____ academic year.
2. The available scholarships that will be awarded for this academic year are as follows:
3. The **deadline** for submitting complete applications (including a completed 4-page **Application Form**, a completed 2-page **Recommendation Form** obtained from the applicant's Civil Engineering Department Head, and a **Transcript of Grades**) for the current school year is _____
4. The Scholarship Committee will finalize a decision regarding the awards at its _____ meeting.
5. Eligible applicants must be **Civil Engineering majors** who are currently into their **Sophomore, Junior** or **Senior year** of study at the time the application is submitted.
6. The applicant must be a **U.S. citizen**.
7. The applicant must meet **at least one** of the following two requirements:
 - A **permanent home residence** in one of the following counties in New Jersey:

Atlantic	Burlington	Camden	Cape May	Cumberland
Gloucester	Ocean	Mercer	Monmouth	Salem
 - A **parent / primary guardian currently enrolled** as a member of the Southern New Jersey Chapter of the American Society of Engineers.
8. Eligible students must be maintaining at least a **2.5 grade point average**.
9. Need, as well as scholastics, will be considered for this award.
10. The aforementioned scholarship(s) will only be awarded on an annual basis. However, students may reapply each year they are eligible.
